I played for Porthleven - my local club - for 30 years between 1975 and 2005, retiring from playing because of a knee injury at age 45. I played mostly as a centre half but was allowed the occasional foray into midfield. I was very fortunate to be part of some very good Porthleven squads, finishing Cornwall Combination League champions twice and runners-up three times. I was selected manager's player & players' player of the year for my club twice, ten years apart.

I started my managerial career at Mullion, re-forming a Reserve side after the club pulled out of the old South Western League, and being beaten Junior Cup finalists in my first season. I returned to manage Mullion in 2013 after the club had stayed up on the last day of the previous season. Three years later we won the Combination League title (with 124 goals for and 31 against). However, the club failed its ground grading for promotion to the Peninsula League and I decided to return to manage my home-town club.

After my first season at Porthleven, the club officials decided to switch their focus away from building upwards from the Youth section, in favour of solely getting the 1st team promoted. This wasn't how I envisage a club to be run, so I decided to part company.

I was then asked by Steve Parker-Billinge to come and help him at Mousehole, and it was something I was considering when I had a call from Godolphin Atlantic. The opportunity to manage in the Premier Division was too good a chance to turn down, and after apologising to Steve I took the job. I really enjoyed my time there and have nothing but praise for the people who run the club. However, we never actually played a full 1st team for the first 8 or 9 games of the season, there was an immense amount of travelling, especially for evening games, and it became more chore than enjoyment. So I decided to step aside and allow Godolphin to find a manager closer to the club.

The following day, I had a 'phone call from Jason Blunt asking if I would be interested in coming for a chat and having a look at what was happening at Mousehole. I came over to speak with the smooth-talking Yorkshireman and got really sucked into everything that was happening within the club, the direction it wanted to go in and, most importantly to me, how it wanted to get there. The Academy and Youth set-up is everything I had been looking for at a football club, and along with the fantastic coaching set up we have, I will do everything to ensure that any success we have will be achieved the correct way, however long that takes.

I live in Carnhell Green with my wife Sarah and 10-year old daughter Ellie. I have worked for two years as supervisor for the cleaning and catering contractor at RNAS Culdrose, after completing 35 years with the Ministry of Defence before taking redundancy. Sarah also works at Culdrose, running the bird control unit on the station, which is responsible for keeping the runways clear of birds, using vehicles and peregrine falcons. Ellie is in her last year at Porthleven Primary school before moving up to secondary school next year.

I hope, for those of you who don't know me, this is a little insight as to who I am. All I can say to you is that, together with everyone else involved in this project, I will give nothing less than 100% commitment and effort to take this football club as far as it can go. If you are not already involved at Mousehole Football Club, get on board and enjoy the ride!

LAST SATURDAY'S FIRST TEAM ACTION MOUSEHOLE 2-1 LUDGVAN / CORNWALL CHARITY CUP, 1st ROUND / SATURDAY 4TH NOVEMBER 2017 / AT TRUNGLE PARC

In West Cornwall's 'Match of the Day', Mousehole and Ludgvan produced a typically hard-fought local derby in front of a large crowd of 153 spectators on a sunny but cool afternoon at the impressively refurbished Trungle Parc, with the hosts just edging through to the second round of the Cornwall 'Durning Lawrence' Charity Cup.

Mousehole came into the match in 14th place in the West Division table, having played their first 10 games away, but with only one defeat in the previous six league and cup matches. Ludgvan on the other hand had made a sensational 10-game unbeaten start to their first season at this level after gaining promotion from the Cornwall Combination, and stood two points ahead at the top of the table with games in hand over the teams just below.

Extra interest was added to an intriguing-looking fixture as Mousehole had won 3-2 at Ludgvan in the League Cup first round back in September, in front of another near-150 crowd.

And just as in that previous cup match, Mousehole made another quick start, going ahead after only 4 minutes when Luke Johnson came inside from the right and placed a low left-foot shot just inside the far post from 15 yards.

Gerens James and Jamie Devine missed clear chances for the visitors before prolific scorer James deservedly equalised on 33 minutes with a clever looping header after Dan Magee's right-sided free kick had been glanced on by Craig Wilcox.

The Seagulls came close when Jordan Adlard fired just over the angle from 30 yards, but it was The Hurlers who were creating the better chances, Jamie Devine heading wide again from a good position and Gerens James through on goal but thwarted by goalkeeper Steve Parker-Billinge's diving save for a corner when a goal looked probable.

So it came as a bit of a surprise when Mousehole regained the lead on 44 minutes, albeit with a superbly worked goal. Recent signing Calum Elliot gained possession in his own half, carried the ball forward with great control and pace, and slid a perfectly-timed defence-splitting pass for the speedy Connor Davey to roll the ball calmly past the advancing Mike Flores for his very first goal in a Mousehole shirt.

Ludgvan came close to getting back on terms in the last action of the first half, SPB palming out a shot and the loose ball being driven across the face of goal with Gerens James lurking.

In a second period with no further goals but plenty of near misses, Ludgvan's direct play and strong running forced Mousehole into their best defensive performance of the season, typified by another flying save by SPB from Ross Duncan's 25-yard drive, several blocks and interceptions at crucial moments, some exciting but unsuccessful breakaways of their own, and in a dramatic last couple of minutes, after Gerens James' unchallenged 10-yard header from a corner had gone marginally wide, Billy Curtis played a true captain's role as he threw himself in front of a great chance for the visitors to take the game into extra time.
