

THE SEAGULLS FIRST TEAM IN ACTION LAST SATURDAY

MOUSEHOLE 2-1 LISKEARD ATHLETIC ◆ SATURDAY 9TH DECEMBER 2017 ◆ SOUTH WEST PENINSULA LEAGUE, WEST DIVISION ◆ AT TRUNGLE PARC

The Seagulls' best performance of the season earned them a richly deserved victory over top-of -the-table Liskeard Athletic, to make it seven home wins out of seven for the season and only one defeat in the last ten matches in all competitions.

Mousehole were without Bradley Wills, Liam Andrew and Billy Curtis, and had Josh Otto and Yeshe Briar on Cornwall U18 duty in Gloucestershire, but welcomed former Scottish Premier League midfielder Kevin Moon to the starting X1, and Paolo Sousa returned to the squad.

The hosts made a bright start and dominated the opening exchanges, but suffered a setback when young centre-back Max Hill withdrew injured after only 15 minutes. Calum Elliot dropped back to fill the gap alongside Jordan Adlard, with Sousa coming off the bench into midfield.

Liskeard showed why they are top of the league by surviving pressure for the first half hour and then going ahead in their first serious attack, Jake Rogers prodding the ball over the line from close in after an angled 25-yard free kick had scuffed its way into the six-yard box. And they nearly doubled the lead on 34 when League top scorer James Lorenz shot towards an open goal after rounding 'keeper Steve Parker-Billinge, but the alert Elliot cleared the ball off the line.

Mousehole returned to the attack but Blues' 'keeper Josh Gilbert made a series of outstanding saves in the ten minutes before half-time to deny Moon, Kevin Lawrence, Sousa and Luke Johnson, while Jake Andrew headed narrowly wide and Tyler Tonkin's shot hit the post.

After another promising opening 15 minutes, the long-awaited equaliser came in the 61st minute, Connor Davey showing great anticipation to get ahead of his marker in front of goal to turn in Johnson's low cross after a superb driving run to the byeline past three defenders on the right hand edge of the penalty area.

With Mousehole well on top, Johnson had a goalbound shot beaten out by Gilbert on 67 before the inevitable second goal arrived in the 69th minute. Davey was again involved, his shot being half cleared before Andrew hooked the loose ball in left-footed into the far corner.

Liskeard came back strongly in the last ten minutes, Parker-Billinge producing a vital diving save on 82, and the resolute defence withstanding two threatening free-kicks and deflecting an on-target header from a dangerous corner.

The three points lift Mousehole up to seventh place in the League table, with the next two home games against teams in the top six. St Dennis' visit today is followed by Porthleven, currently in fourth place, next Saturday 23rd, kick-off at 2:15pm.

NOTES ABOUT ST DENNIS

St Dennis were founder members of the Cornwall Combination League in 1959/60, finishing runners-up in 1970/71 (losing the title on "goal average"), but were crowned champions in 1975/76.

They left the 'Combo' in 1983 and later joined the East Cornwall Premier League, where they were champions in 1991/92 and 1999/2000, going through both seasons undefeated.



They resigned from the ECPL mid-season in 2006/07, but on re-joining that League three years later they became Division 1 and Premier Division champions in successive seasons, the latter achievement earning promotion to the South West Peninsula League, Division 1 West in 2011/12.

In their six seasons in the SWP West Division they have finished 9th, 6th, 9th, 4th, 6th and, last time, 7th.

This season they are going well in 6th place after a slow start. The first fixture in August was a hard-to-forget 4-4 draw with The Seagulls. Jerome Slew had scored a hat-trick to help Mousehole to a healthy 4-1 lead, but in characteristic fashion The Saints fought back in the last 20 minutes, the comeback aided by a bizarre (and wrong) decision by the referee, awarding a goal instead of a goal-kick when a wind-assisted indirect free kick from beyond the half-way line sailed straight into the net.

St Dennis have been involved in several other high-scoring League games. Their wins have included 7-6 at Bude, 4-0 at leaders Ludgvan, and 4-3 and 4-0 at home against Dobwalls and Illogan. Their three losses are 4-0 at home to Wadebridge, 4-0 at Liskeard, and 5-4 at Plymstock. In each of their last four matches they have scored 4.

More high-scoring games have taken place in the Cups. After an impressive 2-1 League Cup first round win at Premier Division Newquay, they then lost 7-5 at Penzance in the second round. In the Cornwall Charity Cup the were ousted at the first hurdle at ECPL Polperro 5-2. But they are still in the Cornwall Senior Cup, having beaten Redruth United 7-0 and then St Stephens Borough 4-1 last Saturday, and face an away tie with Premier Division Bodmin Town in the third round on 6th January.

Carl Rickard is again among the goals, with 10 so far in League and League Cup.

The Saints are currently 5th best in the Disciplinary table, one of only a few teams to have picked up no red cards this season.
