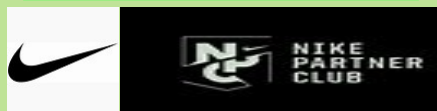

MOUSEHOLE 2-0 WEST CORNWALL FC

THIRD ROUND TIE / SATURDAY 6TH JANUARY 2018 / AT TRUNGLE PARC

Mousehole progressed to the quarter-finals of the County Senior Cup with a goal in each half at the expense of Cornwall Combination side West Cornwall on a bright, cold and windy afternoon at Trungle Parc.

The Seagulls had to work hard against their well-organised lower-league rivals and indeed in an impressive first-half performance the visitors hit the post twice in the 15th and 22nd minutes and had a couple of near-misses, but still went in at the interval a goal down. However, the second half saw Mousehole take control, with their passing and movement pegging The Blues back in their own half for long periods.

West Cornwall's danger-man Jowan Kitchener had driven narrowly over in the 11th minute before Connor Davey put the hosts ahead on 14, firing inside 'keeper Ian Chatfield's near post after a great interception and through-ball by Josh Otto. Tyler Tonkin then came forward from deep to thump a 20-yard shot against the underside of the crossbar and Davey came close to two more goals in the 34th and 45th minutes, the latter a swirling attempt from outside the box expertly tipped over by Chatfield.

Early in the second half, the visitors missed the target on the break in the 54th minute, but the last half-hour belonged to Mousehole, with Tyler Tonkin narrowly over with a 25-yard drive, before substitute Caleb Marsden sped down the left to slide the ball past Chatfield from an angle and Jake Andrew was in the right place to apply a simple finish from close range for 2-0 after 68 minutes. Caleb Marsden was again in action on 84 with a volley from just inside the area that cannoned off the far post and across the line to safety.

A warm welcome to Trungle Parc to all our visitors from Launceston, and of course to all our loyal supporters and interested neutrals, for this previously-postponed 3rd round League Cup tie. Today's winners will go through to the quarter-finals, and a home game in February against Teignmouth from Division One East. An East v West tie will be fascinating for us, although Teignmouth might prefer to travel to Launceston, as the journey to here would be a near 260-mile round trip on the day!

If today's score is level at full-time, there'll be 30 minutes extra time and a penalty shoot-out to decide the tie if necessary. Let's hope it's not too dark by then!

The Seagulls are aiming for more headlines after their first-round League Cup win at previously unbeaten League leaders Ludgvan and the 'scalp' of Premier Division Camelford in the 2nd round. Mousehole are already the longest-surviving West Division club in this year's League Cup competition, and so have qualified for a handy £400 prize money from sponsors Walter C Parson Funeral Directors.

NOTES ABOUT LAUNCESTON AFC

The Clarets are currently 8th in the South West Peninsula League Premier Division, having won 9, drawn 4 and lost 7 of their 20 League fixtures, scoring 45 and conceding 31. They haven't played a League match since 16th December, their last two results being defeats at Helston Athletic 4-1 and leaders Plymouth Parkway 1-0.

Launceston joined the South Western League in 1958/59. They had a year out in 1961/62 and a longer period down in the East Cornwall Premier League from 1966 to 1978 after finishing last or last-but-one for three seasons in a row. They then remained SWL members until the formation of the South West Peninsula League in 2007/08. They had won the SWL title once in 1994/95, but a year later had a run of three seasons finishing in last place.

Their ten seasons in the SWPL Premier Division have seen 5th place achieved on three occasions, but in the last three seasons they have finished mid-table or below.

This season looks more promising, with a 6-1 away and 3-1 home 'double' over Camelford, a 6-0 victory at home against Witheridge, home successes over Stoke Gabriel (4-1), Newquay (1-0), Helston (5-3) and Exmouth (3-0), and 3-1 wins at St Austell and Godolphin Atlantic.

In the SWP League Cup they reached today's third round stage with a 2-1 home win over Brixham from Division 1 East, followed in the second round by a penalty shoot-out home victory against fellow Premier Division team Saltash United. They also won the League Cup in 2006/07, the last season of the South Western League.

The Clarets have won the Cornwall Senior Cup four times, the last time being in 2004/05. They were in 3rd round action two weeks ago, losing 1-0 at Sticker.

This season's stats include:

- Sam Davey is third-equal in the Premier Division scoring charts with 19 goals
- Launceston are middling in the disciplinary table, with 3 red cards & 30 yellows
- Home attendances for League games average 72, with the highest 122 for the opening-day fixture against Plymouth Parkway.



THIS WEEK IN 2004

Goalkeeper **DAVID SEAMAN** retired, with a record of 75 caps for England, 405 appearances for Arsenal, three league championships, four FA Cups, one League Cup, one European Cup Winners Cup, and an MBE in 1997. Rotherham-born, he began at Leeds United, (0 appearances) before moving to Peterborough (91), Birmingham City (75), QPR (145), then Arsenal, and finally Manchester City (19). He appeared in the 1998 (France) and 2002 (South Korea/Japan) World Cups, and the Euros in 1996 (England) and in 2000 (Belgium/Holland). He also made two well-publicised costly errors, one in the last minute of extra time when Real Zaragoza's Nayim hoofed in a speculative 50-yard winner from the touchline in the European Cup Winners Cup Final (1995), and similarly in the 2002 World Cup quarter-final when Ronaldinho's 35-yard free kick drifted in at the far post to give Brazil a 2-1 win.

Manchester United and England's **RIO FERDINAND** started his eight-month ban for missing a drugs test. He said he forgot about it as he was moving house and had to go shopping. His forgetfulness also cost him a £50,000 fine. United finished 3rd in the Premier League that season, 15 points behind unbeaten champions Arsenal.
